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INTRODUCTION

The So'Pony, once known as the Sologn'Pony, is back once again at the Grand Parquet Stadium in Fontainebleau (77) for its 27th edition, from the 19th to 23rd August 2026. The future champions are getting together for the national breed championships: Poney Français de Selle (French Saddle Pony), Dartmoor, New Forest and Welsh, Young Ponies SHF show jumping finals, 3-year-old Sport Championship, as well as the 7-year-old ponies' Championship after being held at the Open de France competition.

The So'Pony plays a crucial role in establishing a link between breeding activity and sporting events, thus allowing ponies to rise to the highest level. This annual event is an ideal opportunity for young ponies to compete before they participate in major events, and it also highlights future champions who have been raised with passion.

The best international performers are a testament to the importance of this competition: names such as Habanera du Loir, Dragibus du Rouget, Go Star de la Butte et Eureka d'Ar Cus all participated at Sologn'Pony at the start of their careers. It is an essential springboard for young ponies, allowing them to reveal their potential and prepare them to reach the highest sporting levels.

THE ASSOCIATIONS



Société Hippique Française (SHF)

Founded in 1865, the Société Hippique Française (French Equine Society), recognised as being of public service, is today the Mother Society of horses and ponies for sport and leisure in France.

The SHF brings together the Selection Programs for sport and leisure horses and ponies, and the regional breeders' societies.

It coordinates and supports the actions of selection programs and distributes financial aid.

It characterises and promotes sports horses and ponies up to 6 years old while respecting animal welfare.

The Young Ponies national show jumping finals for ponies aged 4, 5 and 6 years old, take place during the So'Pony.

In other disciplines, the best young ponies compete during the Grandes Semaines: Hunter, Dressage, Eventing and Carriage Driving.

Through its event circuit, it allows each breeder, owner, rider and driver to support their young horse or pony towards their future sporting career, up to the highest level.



Association Nationale du Poney Français de Selle (ANPFS)

On September 17th in 1969, the Association Française du Poney de Croisement (French Crossbred Pony Association) was created, hoping to promote French breeding products from native pony mares, and pony or thoroughbred stallions. In 1991, the Crossbred Pony became the French Saddle Pony (PFS). The association was then renamed ANPFS: Association Nationale du Poney Français de Selle.

The association manages the Genealogical Book of the breed, approves breeders and organises an important event every year in August: the So'Pony. The members of the society are breeders, owners and users of French Saddle Ponies.

The establishment of a Young Ponies competition circuit made it possible to provide a real selection of stallions. The latter is based on their performance in the Cycle Classique events, but also on their origins and their model type.

The society has 4 reasons for existing: to inform, to act, to support and to bring people together. All this, around the French Saddle Pony.

THE ASSOCIATIONS



French Dartmoor Pony Association

The society is approved as a Selection Program by the Ministry of Agriculture.

Its missions are:

- to study, make known and encourage the breeding of Dartmoor ponies,
- to contribute to the selection of ponies of this breed,
- to bring together breeders, users and enthusiasts of these ponies,
- to promote Dartmoor ponies, in general, to create an interest relating to this breed.

The society organises the National Breed Competition and participates at various events such as agricultural and horse Shows.



French New Forest Pony Association

The AFPNF has been a selection program since 2018. Approved by the Ministry of Agriculture and by the mother studbook of the British breed.

The society is responsible for maintaining the French studbook (genealogical book).

Representative of its members, it guides them, informs them and advises them in the selection. It organises the breeding competitions and is responsible for approving the stallions. Present at national and regional shows, it also promotes the breed in France.

The society has 5 main missions which are also its reasons for existing: to support, inform, promote, select and bring people together around the New Forest pony.



French Welsh Pony and Cob Society

The French Welsh Pony and Cob Society, created in 1967, manages with the IFCE the Genealogical Book of the breed, approves stallions, controls imports and registers imported Welsh ponies and cobs in the French Genealogical Book.

It is recognised by the mother studbook: the WELSH PONY and COB SOCIETY.

It brings together breeders, owners and users of Welsh ponies and cobs. It is managed by a committee of volunteers elected by members.

Its aim is to promote the Welsh breed and contribute to its selection.

- The selection:

The Welsh society organises each year a national competition to which a Welsh judge from the mother studbook is invited and - several regional breed competitions as well.

It manages the selection program and characterisation of breeding stock.

- The promotion

The Welsh Society distributes on request the list of breeders, the list of ponies for sale on its Facebook page, the list of stallions and the list of events organised by the AFPCW.

NATIONAL FINALS SOCIÉTÉ HIPPIQUE FRANÇAISE

Even more impressive, the SHF's events are intended for young show jumping ponies aged 4, 5 and 6 years old in sizes B, C and D.

These finals allow you to observe the young ponies perform to the best of their ability. It is a question of riders, coaches, owners and breeders training and preparing them for conditions that they will encounter in their future sporting careers. Many great international performers have gone through this final before being propelled to the highest level, such as: Habanero du Loir, Dragibus du Rouget, Go Star de la Butte and Eureka d'Ar Cus, have gone through these preparatory events.

Breeders, owners and riders meet every year in the middle of summer to present the elite of their stables while the buyers come to pick up their favourites. After working all year to qualify, the ponies and their team participate in the So'Pony with one main objective: to win the coveted title of Champion of their generations.

Rules & Regulations Modifications 2026

To meet the demands of users and adapt to the evolution of the sport, the Pony Commission works every year to stay in line with its environment. The show-jumping rules are therefore subject to change.

The main regulation modifications for 2026 are stated below:

In regional events, the "label" competitions have been removed. Two Formation pony events have been created: "Formation Pony 70 cm" and "Formation Pony 80 cm." They feature eight jumps without a combination, without earnings, and the "Formation Pony 80 cm" event is a qualifying event for 4-year-old B ponies. Both events are optional for the organiser.

Timed events have been introduced for the 6-year-olds in the Cycle Jeunes Poneys C category and the 6-year-old Cycle Jeunes Poneys D category (second day of the second half of the season).

The number of events allowed per pony per day and per competition has been revised to protect the physical integrity of the young ponies:

The list of bits has been updated. For the horse's well-being, there are new regulations regarding nosebands and fittings, as well as revised technical standards.

For the National Finals, the maximum number of qualifying rounds allowed has been revised:

- 4-year-old ponies: Quota reduced from 18 to 12 rounds allowed
- 5-year-old ponies: Quota reduced from 24 to 14 rounds allowed
- 6-year-old ponies: Quota reduced from 28 to 16 rounds allowed

To obtain 100% of the bonus points, 10 rounds are now required instead of 8.

The rules for qualifying ponies for the Final have been modified.

Crossovers to certain Cycle Libre events have been implemented, with 100% points being counted. Qualifying crossovers for other circuits are available:

- o Hunter: 1 first bonus counts as 1 clear round (maximum 1)
- o Eventing: 1 Eventing bonus counts as 1 clear round (maximum 1)

- 35 top ranked ponies in the TOP 100, 50 are qualifiable (with a minimum of 2 clear rounds)

4-year-old D :

- 140 top ranked ponies in the TOP 100, 200 are qualifiable (with a minimum of 2 clear rounds)

5-year-old ponies

5-year-old B :

- has completed 4 qualifying rounds
- has completed 1 clear round within the year

5-year-old C :

- 30 top ranked ponies in the TOP 100, 45 are qualifiable (with a minimum of 2 clear rounds)

5-year-old D :

- 140 top ranked ponies in the TOP 100, 200 are qualifiable (with a minimum of 2 clear rounds)

6-year-old ponies

6-year-old B :

- has completed 6 qualifying rounds
- has completed 2 clear rounds within the year

6-year-old C :

- 20 top ranked ponies in the TOP 100, 30 are qualifiable (with a minimum of 2 clear rounds)

6-year-old D :

- 100 top ranked ponies in the TOP 100, 140 are qualifiable (with a minimum of 2 clear rounds)

NATIONAL BREED SHOW PONEY FRANÇAIS DE SELLE

The ANPFS organises the French National Championship for the PFS (French Saddle Pony) breed. This championship includes ten categories:

- Young foals
- Older foals
- Broodmares
- Broodmares with PFS factor
- Males 1 year old
- Females 1 year old
- Males 2-year-old
- Females 2-year-old
- Males 3-year-old
- Females 3-year-old

The championship takes place according to a different scheme depending on the category. The broodmares with foals at foot, the foals and the one-year-olds are evaluated only on model and gaits, while the two- and three-year-olds are evaluated over three workshops.

The two-year-old males and females are evaluated on the model, gaits are judged free (walk, trot and canter) and finally ponies are judged on their free jumping. The three-year-old males and females are evaluated on the same criteria, except that gaits are judged under the saddle (ponies are ridden).

For a fourth year, the ANPFS is organising two events reserved for 2 and 3-year-old ponies for the dressage discipline. During this Dressage Label, the ponies are judged on free gait and model, the 3-year-olds are also judged on their ridden gaits. The event will take place from the 19th to the 22nd August.

THE 2026 QUALIFICATIONS

- **Foals** : Overall average superior or equal to 15/20 during a local or regional breed show
- **Broodmares with foal at foot** : Foal's overall average superior or equal to 15/20 during a local or regional breed show.
- **Males and females 1 year old** : Overall average superior or equal to 15,5/20 during a local or regional breed show.
- **Males 2 and 3-year-old** : Two descended testis present. Overall average superior or equal to 15,5/20 during a local or regional breed show.
- **Females 2 and 3-year-old** : Overall average superior or equal to 15/20 during a local or regional breed show.

3-YEAR-OLD SPORT FRENCH CHAMPIONSHIP

For its tenth edition, the 3-year-old Sport Championship organised until now by the Fédération des Poneys et Petits Chevaux de France (French Federation of Ponies and Small Horses) is taken over by the SHF. This inter-breed championship for three-year-old sport ponies will take place similarly to the three-year-old PFS Championship, i.e.: a model event, an under-saddle gait event and a free jumping event.

The ponies that will be presented must be registered in one of the following twelve studbooks: Connemara, Criollo, Dartmoor, Fjord, Haflinger, Highland, Irish Cob, Icelandic, New Forest, French Saddle Pony, Shetland and Welsh. In addition to the males and females, geldings will be able to compete for this championship. Since 2021, category E ponies can also compete in this Championship.

The AFPCW will make the most of this Championship to crown the best Welsh pony in the Sport category.

A committee of experts appointed by the ANPFS will select the best 3-year-old males, based on their performance and genetic value at the end of the three workshops. They will then be allowed to participate in the testing of PFS and 3-year-old PFS factor stallions and obtain their approbation.

7-YEAR-OLD CHAMPIONSHIP

Participation conditions

The riders may ride 4 ponies. Changing riders is permitted within the framework of the regulatory procedure before the start of the 1st round.

- Licence : Club, Amateur or Pro
- Galop 7 level minimum
- 7-year-old pony

Rules and regulations for the 7-year-old Championship

- 1st round- the 20th August 2026 (bareme A timed): the penalty points during the round are taken into account to generate the provisional ranking.
- 2nd round – the 21st August 2026 (bareme A without time): Starting order: in reverse order of the provisional ranking. In case of a tie: in order of the program. Those who are eliminated and/or retire in the first round are permitted to take part in the second round with the penalties of the last ranked plus 100 points.
- Final – 22nd August 2026 (bareme A without time): Reserved to the TOP 30 ranked after the 1st and 2nd round. Starting order: in reverse order of the provisional ranking. In case of a tie: in order of the program. Any ties in points for 1st and/or 2nd and/or 3rd place will be decided with a timed jump-off following the final. Other participants tied in points are ranked following their times from round 1.

Prize Giving

Plaques, ribbons, gifts... are distributed to the first 8 ranked in the Championship.

Intended to highlight the best females of the PFS breed, this evening, similar to the Soiree de l'Avenir evening dedicated to the males, it will showcase and honour the future performance and breeding mares of the breed. After, head over to the Loung evening!

On Saturday 22nd August, the unmissable Soirée de l'Avenir will be held. You will witness a showcase of the 2- and 3-year-old stallions who have been approved at the PFS National!



PONEY FRANÇAIS DE SELLE

Origins

The PFS is a crossbred pony originally resulting from the marriage of native ponies of French origin (recorded from 1976) with pony (Connemara, New Forest, Welsh, etc.) or thoroughbred stallions.

Characteristics

Distinction and refinement are the key words to describe this little horse. A reliable and versatile ride, this accomplished athlete represents the perfect match between the hardiness of ponies and the gaits and sporting abilities of horses..

Model

Measuring less than 148 cm, the charismatic PFS displays a harmonious model, matched by a coat in multiple variations. With its expressive gaits and stable temperament, it embodies the perfect blend of performance and elegance.

Utilisation

A good temperament and undeniable sporting qualities allow the PFS to shine in any situation. A school pony by excellence, its versatility makes it an ideal ride for leisure, pony games, horse ball, or driving. A born competitor, it also distinguished itself in show jumping, dressage, and eventing. Its talent allowed it to shine on the international scene, raising the breed to the level of unavoidable sporting reference.

NEW FOREST

Origins

The New Forest pony is originally from the South of England, found in the New Forest hence its name.

Characteristics

The New Forest pony is athletic, expressive, harmonious and solid. Its temperament and its abilities for sport and leisure have been carefully selected for generations. The breeders carefully breed robust ponies, with an athletic model all while prioritising the breed's characteristics, with a gentle temperament.

Model

We particularly appreciate a model with a distinguished head with a large and flat forehead. The neckline must be well attached, with some length and not too thick. The shoulder must be oblique, powerful hindquarters, strong bones with distinct joints, deep chest, straight legs and round and solid hooves. The movements of a New Forest pony must be expressive and active. A new-Forest pony must not measure more than 148cm and is rarely smaller than 120cm.

Utilisation

The New Forest pony is known for its versatility: we often find them of the podiums of high-level events, whether it be show jumping, eventing, dressage, carriage driving or endurance, but also for leisure and as club ponies. Its robustness enables it to be ridden by children as well as adults.

Origins

Capable of carrying an adult and sufficiently gentle for a young child, it is favourite with children and parents who mention its easiness to ride compared to other breeds. Sport pony by excellence, the Connemara is present all over the world on show grounds, in show jumping, eventing and dressage where they excel to the highest level. The Connemara has been the most used genetic in France, used to improve and produce crossbred ponies for a career in sport.

WELSH

Origins

The Welsh pony is a breed that originates from Wales.

Characteristics

To this day, five sections are open to differentiate the types of Welsh pony:

- -The Welsh Mountain (section A) is the oldest type in the Welsh breed, the origin of all other sections of this breed. Measuring up to 122cm, it is rightly so described as a “miniature purebred Arabian”. It has a distinct, supple and bright movement, and impulsion.
- -The Welsh Pony (section B) resembles the Welsh A pony but with more substance and bigger in size.
- -The Welsh Pony Type Cob (section C) is more robust than the Welsh B, due to the cob bloodlines. It does not measure more than 137,2cm.
- -The Welsh Cob, measuring more than 137,2cm, product of crossbreeding a Welsh Mountain mare and a Spanish war horse, combining elegance and agility with strength and robustness.
- -The Welsh K is a pony or a horse with at least 12,5% Welsh bloodlines.
- These sections offer very versatile ponies with athleticism, energy and strength. Great schoolmaster ponies, it combines courage and intelligence with expressive movement and has a natural gift for show jumping. Excellent in sport, we can often find them on the podium in show jumping, eventing, dressage and carriage driving.

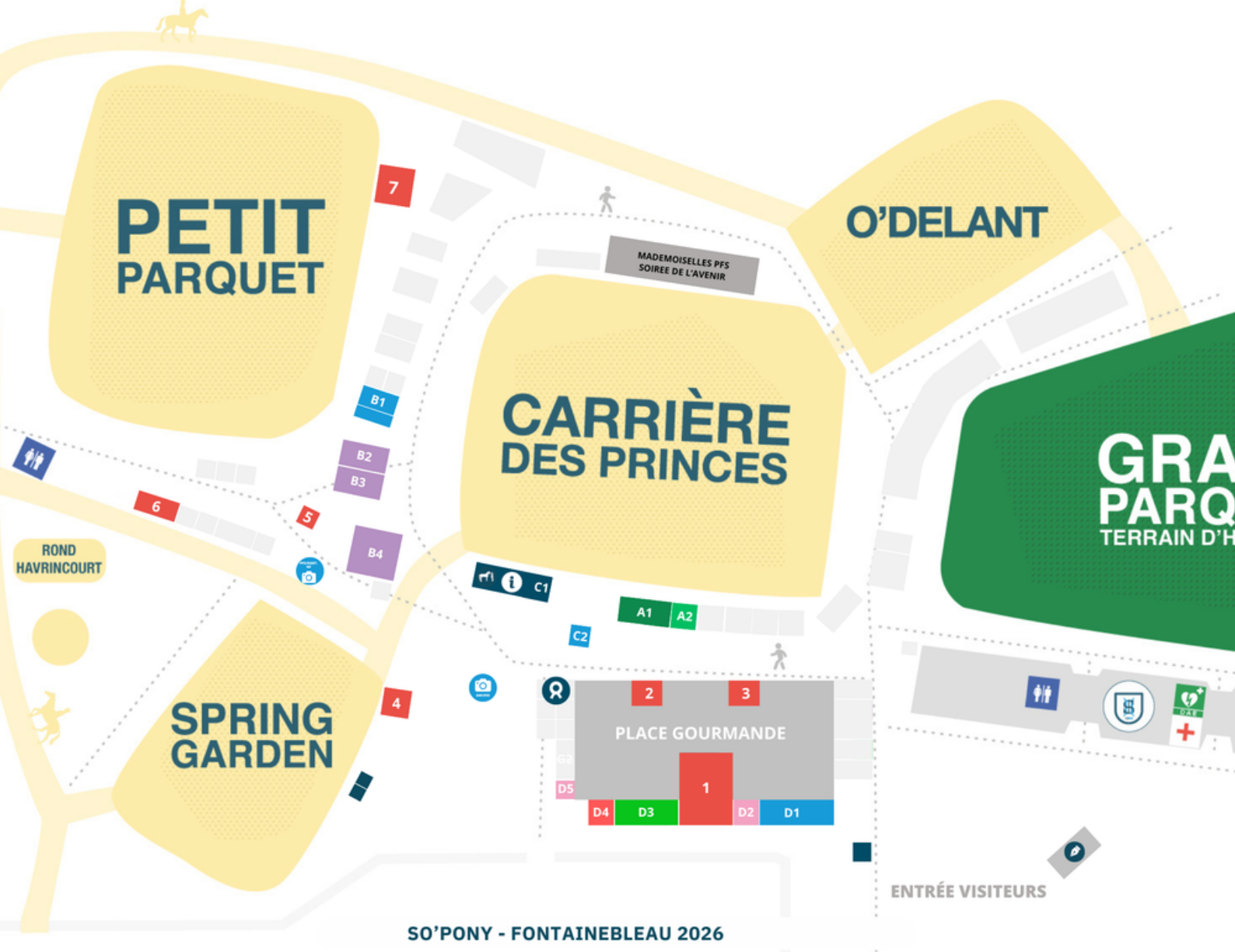
